RESOLUTION No. 187

RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING THE NATIONAL JIU-JITSU TEAM FOR THEIR IMPRESSIVE WINS IN THE 7TH ASIAN JIU-JITSU CHAMPIONSHIP HELD LAST FEBRUARY 24 TO 28, 2023 IN BANGKOK, THAILAND

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has consistently recognized outstanding Filipinos who bring honor and glory to the nation through their remarkable feats and prestigious awards;

WHEREAS, the 2023 Asian Jiu-Jitsu Championship held from February 24 to 28, 2023 in Bangkok, Thailand is considered the most participated in the history of Asian jiu-jitsu, with a record 581 entries from thirty (30) countries, more than double the 263 contestants from 22 nations in the last edition:

WHEREAS, the National Jiu-Jitsu Team clinched four gold and two bronze medals and finished second overall in the event;

WHEREAS, two-time world champion Meggie Ochoa bagged a gold medal by emerging victorious in the Women's Adult-48kg division;

WHEREAS, three more gold medals were hauled by Southeast Asian gold medalist Annie Ramirez (57kg), Jenna Kaila Napolis (52kg), and 19-year-old Dylan Valmores (70kg) in their respective divisions;

WHEREAS, Marc Alexander Lim and Andrea Lois Lao also won two bronze medals in the Men-69kg and Women-63kg categories, respectively;

WHEREAS, the exemplary performance of the Philippine Team deserves recognition for bringing honor to the nation, and for inspiring Filipino athletes to be the best in their respective disciplines: Now, therefore, be it
