RESOLUTION
CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING FILIPINO BOXER, PEDRO TADURAN JR., FOR WINNING THE WORLD MINIMUMWEIGHT TITLE OF THE INTERNATIONAL BOXING FEDERATION (IBF)
