RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, after that initial but highly successful stint, she produced local films that started with "Araw-Araw, Gabi-Gabi" starring Charito Solis and Didith Reyes which opened in cinemas on September 21, 1975;

WHEREAS, among her critically-acclaimed masters include "Manila By Night," "Sister Stella L," and "Broken Marriage";
