RESOLUTION

CONFERRING THE PHILIPPINE SENATE MEDAL OF EXCELLENCE TO CARLOS EDRIEL YULO FOR WINNING TWO GOLD MEDALS IN THE 2024 PARIS OLYMPICS

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Philippines has consistently recognized and commended Filipinos who have excelled in their field of expertise and served as a symbol of hope to the Filipino nation;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 110 provides that the Philippine Senate Medal of Excellence be conferred upon Filipinos who are awarded an Olympic medal;

WHEREAS, on August 04, 2024, Carlos Yulo made history as the first Filipino male athlete to win an Olympic gold medal when he secured the top spot in men's artistic gymnastics floor exercise finals;

WHEREAS, on Augst 05, 2024, he made history again as the first Filipino athlete to win multiple golds at a single Olympic when he bagged his second gold medal by taking the top spot in men's vault;

WHEREAS, Carlos Yulo was born on February 16, 2000 in Manila. He is the eldest son of Mark Andrew and Angelica Yulo;

WHEREAS, a product of Palarong Pambansa, a Philippine sports grassroots development program, he became the first Filipino artistic gymnast to win a medal at the world championships by claiming bronze in the floor exercise at the 2018 edition of the tournament in Doha, Qatar;

WHEREAS, Carlos Yulo's impressive achievements include winning multiple gold medals at the Southeast Asian Games and the World Gymnastics Championships, showcasing his exceptional talent and commitment to his sports;

WHEREAS, his success has not only brought honor and glory to our country but has also inspired countless Filipinos, particularly the youth, to strive for excellence and embrace the spirit of perseverance and hard work;

WHEREAS, he has consistently demonstrated exceptional skill, dedication, and sportsmanship in the field of gymnastics, significantly contributing to our country's prestige on the international stage;

WHEREAS, Carlos Yulo's achievements reflect the rich potential and global competitiveness of Filipino athletes, and his contributions to sports have fostered national pride and unity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Senate of the Philippines confers the Philippine Senate Medal of Excellence to Carlos Edriel Yulo for his remarkable achievement of being the first Filipino athlete to win two Olympic gold medals, thereby bringing honor to the Republic of the Philippines and serving as an inspiration to the Filipino people.
