RESOLUTION

CONCURRING IN THE RATIFICATION OF INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ORGANIZATION CONVENTION NO. 81 OR THE "CONVENTION CONCERNING LABOUR INSPECTION IN INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE (ILO C81)"

- WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 21 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that, "No treaty or international agreement shall be valid and effective unless
- 3 concurred in by at least two-thirds of all the Members of the Senate";
- WHEREAS, the *International Labour Organization Convention No. 81* or the Convention Concerning Labour Inspection in Industry and Commerce (ILO C81) was signed and was adopted by the International Labour Organization (ILO) General Conference in Geneva, Switzerland on 11 July 1947;
- WHEREAS, the *ILO C81* aims to ensure effectiveness and efficiency of labor inspection in industrial and commercial workplaces;
- WHEREAS, the *ILO C81* is in line with the Philippines' commitment to afford full respect and protection to labor while recognizing the principle of shared responsibility between workers and employers;
- 13 **WHEREAS**, the *ILO C81* will encourage international cooperation and 14 exchanges of best practices in labor inspection among ILO Member States;

- WHEREAS, the President of the Philippines ratified the Convention on 29
 November 2023 and has submitted it to the Senate for concurrence, in accordance
 with the Constitution of the Philippines;
- WHEREAS, in the hearing conducted by the Senate Committee on Foreign
 Relations on 16 April 2024, the following government agencies endorsed the
 concurrence to the ratification of the Agreement:
 - 1. Department of Foreign Affairs; and
- 8 2. Department of Labor and Employment.

Now, therefore, be it

- *RESOLVED*, That the Senate of the Philippines concur, as it hereby concurs, in the Philippine ratification of the *International Labour Organization Convention No.*12 81 or the Convention Concerning Labour Inspection in Industry and Commerce (ILO C81).
- 14 **RESOLVED, finally,** That the President of the Philippines may, with the 15 concurrence of the Senate, withdraw from the Agreement.
