RESOLUTION

CONCURRING IN THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES AND JAPAN CONCERNING THE FACILITATION OF RECIPROCAL ACCESS AND COOPERATION BETWEEN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE PHILIPPINES AND THE SELF-DEFENSE FORCES OF JAPAN

- WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 21 of the Philippine Constitution states that,
 "No treaty or international agreement shall be valid and effective unless concurred in
 by at least two-thirds of all the Members of the Senate";
 - WHEREAS, the Agreement Between the Republic of the Philippines and Japan Concerning the Facilitation of Reciprocal Access and Cooperation Between the Armed Forces of the Philippines and the Self-Defense Forces of Japan ("Agreement") was signed on 8 July 2024 in Manila;
 - **WHEREAS**, the Agreement outlines the provisions on entry and departure, movement, access to facilities and professional practice of the Visiting Force and Civilian Component for the purpose of cooperative activities, as well as the rules governing the jurisdiction over the actions of the Visiting Force and Civilian Components;
 - **WHEREAS**, the Agreement aims to deepen the security and defense cooperation between the Philippines and Japan, as well as enhance the interoperability between the Armed Forces of the Philippines and the Self-Defense Forces of Japan by

1	enabling a more in-depth practical military cooperation and exercises between both		
2	countries;		
3	WH	EREAS , the Agreement will expand the defense cooperation of the	
4	Philippines and Japan in the maritime domain amid shared security challenges;		
5	WHEREAS, ratifying the Agreement further affirms the strategic partnership		
6	between the two countries and their mutual goal to enhance contribution to regional		
7	and international peace, security, and stability;		
8	WHEREAS, the President of the Philippines ratified the Agreement on 5		
9	November 2024 and has submitted it to the Senate for concurrence, in accordance		
10	with the Co	onstitution of the Philippines;	
11	WH	EREAS, in the hearing conducted by the Senate Committee on Foreign	
12	Relations on 25 November 2024, the following government agencies endorsed the		
13	concurrence in the ratification of the Agreement:

- *RESOLVED, further,* That well-delineated provisions on custody of members of the Visiting Force or Civilian Component will be set forth in the implementing agreement.
- *RESOLVED, furthermore,* That the Department of National Defense committed to further clarify the present provisions on jurisdiction in the implementing agreement.
- *RESOLVED, finally,* That the President of the Philippines may, with the concurrence of the Senate, withdraw from the Agreement.
