RESOLUTION

AMENDING SECTION 20 OF THE RULES OF PROCEDURE GOVERNING **INQUIRIES IN AID OF LEGISLATION**

1 WHEREAS, Section 19 of the Rules Of Procedure Governing Inquiries In Aid Of 2 Legislation ("Rules of Procedure") adopted by the Senate on 7 August 1987 provides 3 that "the Committee or its Chairman, may from time to time constitute and appoint 4 subcommittees, including ad hoc or select subcommittees, composed of less than a 5 majority of the committee members for the purpose of performing any and all acts 6 which the Committee as a whole is authorized to do and perform, except the power 7 to punish for contempt under Section 17 hereof."

8 WHEREAS, Section 20 of the current Rules of Procedure adopted on 9 August 9 2010 states that "The Chairman of the Committee may create subcommittees as may be deemed necessary for the purpose of performing any and all acts which the 10 11 Committee as a whole is authorized to do and perform, except the power to punish 12 for contempt under Section 18 hereof."

13 WHEREAS, Section 20 of the Rules of Procedure provides for the delegation of 14 the Committee's authority to subcommittees, but withholds from such delegation, the 15 contempt power as contemplated in Section 18 of the Rules of Procedure, considering 16 that a subcommittee may constitute less than a majority of the committee members.

17 WHEREAS, Congress' contempt power has long been established and 18 recognized in jurisprudence as inherent and essential to the legislature's discharge of 19 its functions, allowing Congress to perform its duties without impediment, to assert its 20 authority, and punish contumacious acts independently of the judicial branch.

1 WHEREAS, recently-constituted subcommittees comprise the same 2 membership as the main committee and should therefore be allowed to wield the 3 committee's full powers, including the power to cite and punish witnesses in contempt: 4 *Now, therefore, be it*

5 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, to amend Section 20 of the Rules of Procedure 6 Governing Inquiries in Aid of Legislation to read as follows:

Sec. 20. Subcommittees; Delegation of Authority. The Chairman
of a Committee may create subcommittees as may be deemed
necessary for the purpose of performing any and all acts which the
Committee as a whole is authorized to do and perform[,except the
power to punish for contempt under Section 18 hereof].
