RESOLUTION
HONORING AND CELEBRATING THE LIVES, LEGACY, AND MINISTRY
OF APOSTLE ARSENIO TAN FERRIOL AND APOSTLE JONATHAN
SANTOS FERRIOL, ESTEEMED LEADERS OF THE PENTECOSTAL
MISSIONARY CHURCH OF CHRIST (4TH WATCH), ON THE OCCASION
OF THEIR BIRTHDAYS ON JANUARY 14

1 WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate proudly recognizes and honors the
