RESOLUTION
COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING DENICE ZAMBOANGA FOR
WINNING THE ONE INTERIM WOMEN'S ATOMWEIGHT MMA WORLD
TITLE IN BANGKOK, THAILAND

1 WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 19 of the Philippine Constitution
2 mandates that "the State shall promote physical education and encourage
3 sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training
4 for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork and
5 excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry";

7 WHEREAS, the Senate of the Philippines recognizes and honors
8 outstanding Filipino athletes whose exemplary performances bring pride and
9 glory to the nation;

11 WHEREAS, Denice Zamboanga made history on January 11, 2025, by
12 becoming the first-ever Filipina to win the ONE Interim Women's Atomweight
13 MMA World Title at ONE Fight Night 27, held at the Lumpinee Stadium in
14 Bangkok, Thailand;

16 WHEREAS, Zamboanga delivered a spectacular performance against
17 Alyona Rassohyna of Ukraine, achieving a technical knockout (TKO) victory at
18 4 minutes and 47 seconds of Round Number 2 in the co-main event of the
19 evening;

21 WHEREAS, this historic achievement underscores Denice Zamboanga's
22 dedication, discipline, and perseverance in the highly competitive field of mixed

1 martial arts, inspiring countless Filipinos, particularly young women, to pursue
2 excellence in sports;

4 WHEREAS, her victory also showcases the immense talent and potential
5 of Filipino athletes on the global stage, further solidifying the Philippines'
6 reputation as a powerhouse in combat sports: Now, therefore, be it
