RESOLUTION

COMMENDING THE HONORABLE RAMON B. MAGSAYSAY, JR. FOR HIS INVALUABLE AND DEDICATED SERVICE TO THE SENATE AND THE NATION DURING HIS TERMS AS SENATOR

WHEREAS, the Honorable Ramon B. Magsaysay, Jr., has served this august Chamber for twelve (12) consecutive years (1995-2001 and 2001-2007) and chaired the committees on Trade and Commerce; Agriculture and Food; National Defense and Security; Science and Technology; Cooperatives; and Peace, Unification and Reconciliation;
