RESOLUTION

COMMENDING THE HONORABLE SENATOR RALPH G. RECTO FOR HIS STERLING PERFORMANCE DURING THE 12TH AND 13TH CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES

WHEREAS, after having served the House of Representatives for three consecutive terms as representative of the 4th district of Batangas, Senator Recto was elected senator in 2001 and was chosen to head the powerful Committee on Ways and Means;
